GROWING FROM SEED



WHY GROW FROM SEED?

- Saves money
- Access to a greater variety than seedlings available
- Inexpensive way to try new things
- Control over the whole process

REQUIREMENTS

- Air
- Light
- Moisture
- Temperature



WHAT COULD GO WRONG? Little or no germination

- Sow at correct time
- Don't sow too deeply
- Germination test first

WHAT COULD GO WRONG? Failure to thrive / stunted growth SOLUTIONS

- Sow at correct time
- Correct watering

Seeds or seedlings attacked

SOLUTIONS

 Cover appropriately with insect or bird netting

Sudden death: "damping off"



Sudden death: "damping off"

- Try dusting soil with cinnamon
- Water from bottom, not top
- Dispose of seed raising mix if problem persists & wash everything thoroughly

Leggy seedlings



- Move where they will get more light
- When potting on or transplanting, plant a little deeper

Main stem broken

- Handle seedlings by leaves not stem
- Keep seedlings out of strong winds


Forgotten what you planted where

- Take photos of where you plant things
- Label, label, label

Labelling

- Essential:
 - Full, correct name of plant

- Nice to have:
 - Date sown
 - Date potted
 - Date transplanted
