Amaranth - grain and leaf types	→	Transplant seedlings into garden
Angelica	→	Plant in garden
Artichokes – Globe types	→	Plant in garden
Asparagus	→	Plant in garden
Asparagus Pea (aka winged bean)	→	Plant in garden
Basil	→	Transplant seedlings into garden
Beans – climbing (pole, runner, scarlet runner)	→	Plant in garden
Beans (dwarf, French, bush)	→	Plant in garden
Beetroot - also manglewurzel, sugarbeet	→	Plant in garden
Borage (aka burrage, Bugloss)	→	Plant in garden
Broccoli	→	Transplant seedlings into garden
Burdock – (aka Gobo, Japanese Burdock)	→	Plant in garden
Cabbage	→	Transplant seedlings into garden
Cape Gooseberry (Golden Berry, Inca Berry)	→	Plant in garden
Capsicum (Bell Peppers, Sweet Peppers)	→	Transplant seedlings into garden
Carrot	→	Plant in garden
Celeriac	→	Start undercover in seed trays. Plant out in 4-6 weeks
Celery	→	Start undercover in seed trays. Plant out in 4-6 weeks
Chicory (aka Witlof, Belgian Endive)	→	Plant in garden
Chillies (aka Hot Peppers)	→	Transplant seedlings into garden
Chinese Cabbage (aka Wombok, Michihli)	→	Plant in garden
Chives - Onion and Garlic	→	Plant in garden
Coriander (aka Cilantro, Chinese Parsley)	→	Plant in garden
Cowpeas (aka Black Eyed Peas, Southern Peas)	→	Plant in garden
Cucumber	→	Plant in garden
Eggplant (Aubergine)	→	Transplant seedlings into garden
Endives – (Broad leaf, King, Scullora)	→	Plant in garden
Florence Fennel – (Finocchio, and Bronze Fennel)	→	Plant in garden
French Tarragon	→	Plant in garden
Horseradish	→	Plant in garden
Jerusalem Artichoke (aka Sunchoke)	→	Plant in garden
Kangkong (Kang Kung water vegetable)	→	Plant in well composted pot and place at edge of garden pond
Kohlrabi	→	Plant in garden
Leeks	→	Transplant seedlings into garden
Lemon Balm (Lemon Mint, Sweet Balm, Melissa)	→	Plant in garden
Lettuce	→	Plant in garden

Loufah (luffa, bath sponge vine)	→	Transplant seedlings into garden
Marrow	→	Plant in garden
Mint (aka Garden Mint, Spearmint, Peppermint etc)	→	Start undercover in seed trays. Plant out in 4-6 weeks
Mizuna - Japanese greens, Mitzuna and Mibuna	→	Plant in garden
Mustard greens – (Gai Choy, Red Giant, Giant Purple Osaka	→	Plant in garden
Okra (aka Lady Finger, Gumbo)	→	Start undercover in seed trays. Plant out in 4-6 weeks
Oregano (aka Pot Marjoram)	→	Plant in garden
Parsley – all, Curly, Giant Florentine, Italian Flat Leaf, Moss and Triple Curled	→	Plant in garden
Pumpkin	→	Plant in garden
Radish - summer radishes	→	Plant in garden
Rocket (aka Arugula, Rucola)	→	Plant in garden
Rockmelon (aka Canteloupe)	→	Plant in garden
Rosella (aka QLD Jam Plant, Roselle)	→	Must be started in mini greenhouse. Plant out in 4-6 weeks
Rosemary	→	Plant in garden
Sage (Culinary or Garden Sage)	→	Plant in garden
Salsify (aka vegetable oyster)	→	Plant in garden
Savory (aka Summer & Winter Savory Bean Herb)	→	Transplant seedlings into garden
Silverbeet – (aka Swiss Chard or Mangold)	→	Transplant seedlings into garden
Spring Onions (aka Scallions, Welsh, Bunching)	→	Plant in garden
Squash (aka Crookneck, Patty Pan, Summer)	→	Plant in garden
Radish - summer radishes	→	Plant in garden
Squash (aka Crookneck, Patty Pan, Summer)	→	Plant in garden
Sunflowers	→	Plant in garden
Sweet Corn (aka Maize)	→	Plant in garden
Sweet Marjoram (aka Knotted Marjoram)	→	Plant in garden
Thyme	→	Transplant seedlings into garden
Tomatillo	→	Transplant seedlings into garden

Turnip	→	Plant in garden
Warrigal Spinach (aka New Zealand Spinach)	→	Start undercover in seed trays. Plant out in 4-6 weeks
Watermelon	→	Start in ground in biodegradable pots
Yacon (aka Sun Root)	→	Plant in garden
Yam / Oca	→	Plant in garden
Zucchini (aka Courgette / Marrow, Summer Squash)	→	Plant in garden
